AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to the display of the flag of the United States on school property and at school events.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-1001, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection:

All displays of the flag of the United States on school property and at school events shall conform to the manner of display as prescribed in federal law, 4 U.S.C. §§ 1-10, and taught in the public schools pursuant to subsection (a). A local board of education shall permit the display of the flag of the United States on school property or at a school event; provided, that the flag is properly displayed according to federal law.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


