## **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 830**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 3, Part 8 and Title 57, Chapter 4, relative to consumption of alcoholic beverages at retail food stores.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-817, is amended by deleting the following language:

; provided, that:

(1) The premises of the on-premise licensee shall be separate and distinct from the premises of the retail food store; and

(2) The business of the on-premise licensee shall be operated separately and distinctly from the operation of the business of the retail food store wine licensee

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-201(b)(1) is amended by adding the following language after the second sentence in the subdivision:

Notwithstanding § 57-3-803, the commission is authorized to issue a limited license to a retail food store authorizing a restaurant within a retail food store to serve wine but no other alcoholic beverages within a designated area within the retail food store. A retail food store may receive a restaurant license under this section without complying with seating requirements or requirements regarding minimum food sales for a wine only licensee as long as the retail food store provides prepared food for sale to customers and pays a license fee equal to the license fee in § 57-4-301(b)(1)(R)(vii).

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
