AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 10, Chapter 7, Part 5, relative to the confidentiality of records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515, as amended by Chapter ___ of the Public Acts of 2016 (Senate Bill 2034 / House Bill 2080), is amended by deleting the language "under § 4-4-125 relative to the nondisclosure of social security numbers" and substituting instead the language "under § 10-7-504(a)(28) relative to the nondisclosure of personally identifying information".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515, as amended by Chapter ___ of the Public Acts of 2016 (Senate Bill 2034 / House Bill 2080), is further amended by deleting the phrases "a social security identification number", "social security identification number", "social security identification numbers", and "social security number" wherever they appear and substituting instead the language "personally identifying information".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515, as amended by Chapter ___ of the Public Acts of 2016 (Senate Bill 2034 / House Bill 2080), is further amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

() As used in this section, "personally identifying information" has the same meaning as defined in § 10-7-504(a)(28).

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016, the public welfare requiring it.
