# EXECUTIVE ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR

**AN ORDER AMENDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 28  
RELATIVE TO RESERVE COMPONENTS ORDERED TO  
ACTIVE DUTY UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF A GOVERNOR**

**WHEREAS**, members of the Reserve Components of Armed Forces of the United States of America have been ordered to active duty under my authority, and under the authority of governors of other states, in support of an operation ("the operation") undertaken in response to the terrorist attacks that occurred on September 11, 2001;

**NOW THEREFORE**, I, Don Sundquist, Governor of the State of Tennessee, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Tennessee Constitution and law, do hereby order and direct the following:

Executive Order 28 is hereby amended to include the phrase "or under the authority of a governor" after each occurrence of the phrase "President of the United States." The phrase "or under the authority of a governor" shall apply to any employee of the State of Tennessee who is a member of a Reserve Component and is ordered to active duty under my authority in support of the operation. This phrase shall also apply to any employee of the State of Tennessee who is member of a Reserve Component in another state and is ordered to active duty under the authority of the governor of the other state in support of the operation.

This amendment shall be effective as of the date of signing of Executive Order 28.
