PROCLAMATION 16-10

EMERGENCY CLOSURE OF DEER SEASON DUE TO FLOODING

Pursuant to the authority granted by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-4-107(c)(3) the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission, hereby proclaims the emergency closure of deer season due to historic flooding. The following areas are now closed:

All areas west of Highway 78 from the Kentucky State line to the Obion River Bridge, and west of the Obion River from the Highway 78 Bridge to the Mississippi River, shall be closed to deer hunting on January 9 and 10, 2016.

These measures are being taken to assure and protect public health, safety, and welfare and to assure that the welfare of the wildlife resources in the affected areas is reasonably protected.
