Proclaiming Gray's Creek Wildlife Management Area

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a wildlife management area to be known as Gray's Creek Wildlife Management Area.

Those lands and waters in Hardeman County in Tennessee west of State Route 18, north of Bolivar, east of Vildo Road and south of Highway 100 owned by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency.

The boundary line is marked with "TWRA Wetland Area" and/or "Wildlife Management Area" signs. A more complete description may be found on file in the Real Estate Division office of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency in Nashville, Tennessee.


