Proclaiming Waterbury Refuge

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a wildlife refuge to be known as Waterbury Refuge.

Those lands and waters in Shelby County in Tennessee west of Highway 14 (Jackson Avenue), north of I-40, east of Wartford Road and south of James Road owned by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency.


