Proclaiming Big Springs Public Hunting Area

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a public hunting area to be known as Big Springs Public Hunting Area.

Those lands and waters in Sullivan County in Tennessee on the South Holston River, west and north of Highway 44, east of Highway 358-Weaver Pike and south of the South Holston River and Big Springs Road owned by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency.


