Proclamation No. 16-17

Proclaiming Lytle Creek Refuge

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a wildlife refuge to be known as Lytle Creek Refuge.

Those lands and waters in Rutherford County in Tennessee west of Bradyville Pike-Highway 99, north of Dilton Mankin Road, east of Manchester Pike-Highway 41 and south of South Rutherford Boulevard owned by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency.

A more complete description may be found on file in the Real Estate Division office of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency in Nashville, Tennessee.


