Proclaiming Mullins Island Public Hunting Area

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a public hunting area to be known as Mullins Island Public Hunting Area.

Those lands and waters located in northern Cocke County in Tennessee on the Nolichucky River, west of Highway 340 – Fish Hatchery Road, north and east of Highway 160 – Enka Highway, south of I- 81 owned by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency.
