Proclamation No. 16-21

Proclaiming Murfree Springs Refuge

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a wildlife refuge to be known as Murfree Springs Refuge.

Those lands and waters in Rutherford County in Tennessee west of Highway 70S, north of Mercury Boulevard, east of I-24 and S. Church Street and south of Old Fort Parkway owned by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency. Located on S.E. Broad Street in Murfreesboro.

A more complete description may be found on file in the Real Estate Division office of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency in Nashville, Tennessee.


