Proclamation 11-05

Importation of Cervid Carcasses and Parts

Pursuant to the authority granted by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-206 and 70-4-107, the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Commission hereby proclaims carcass importation restrictions effective August 1, 2011:

Section I. Chronic Wasting Disease Containment Zones

- A. The following U.S. states, portions of states, and Canadian provinces are proclaimed to be CWD positive and are therefore regulated by rule 1660-1-15:

- B. And any other state or province where a positive case of CWD has been detected as confirmed by USDA or CFIA.
