Proclaiming Thorny Cypress Wildlife Management Area

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, and Section 70-1-302 and 70-5-101 thereof, the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Commission, hereby proclaims the area below as a wildlife management area and hereafter to be known as Thorny Cypress Wildlife Management Area.

Those lands and waters owned by the State of Tennessee in Dyer County, Tennessee, and under the jurisdictional authority of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, south of White Lake Refuge and north of Hwy. 104 in the Obion River watershed acres as posted.

The boundary line is posted with "Wildlife Management Area" signs. A more complete description for this tract may be found on file in the Engineering Division office of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, Nashville, Tennessee.


