Proclamation No. 15-07

Proclaiming Wolf River Wildlife Management Area

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following areas as a wildlife management area to be known as Wolf River Wildlife Management Area.

Those lands and waters in southern Fayette and Shelby Counties in Tennessee east of Highway 385 in Shelby county, north of the Mississippi state line, west of the Hardeman county line, and south of Raleigh-LaGrange Drive within the Wolf River flood plain and owned, leased, managed, or under MOU by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency.

The boundary lines are marked with "TWRA Wetland Area", "Wildlife Management Area", or TDEC Division of Natural Heritage Ghost River State Natural Area signs. A more complete description may be found on file in the Real Estate Division office of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency in Nashville, Tennessee.

This proclamation repeals proclamation 95-22.


