Proclaiming White Lake Refuge

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, and Section 70-1-302 and 70-5-101 thereof, the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Commission, hereby proclaims the area described below as a wildlife management area and hereafter to be known as White Lake Refuge Wildlife Management Area.

Those lands and waters owned by the State of Tennessee in Dyer County, Tennessee and under the jurisdictional authority of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, consisting of 938 acres and known as the Broadbent purchase and 257 acres known as the John McCullough purchase.

A more complete description for this tract may be found on file in the Engineering Division office of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, Nashville, Tennessee.

This proclamation repeals the paragraph proclaiming White Lake Refuge of Proclamation No. 90-15, dated May 31, 1990.
