Proclaiming Middle Fork Forked Deer Refuge

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a wildlife refuge to be known as Middle Fork Forked Deer Refuge.

Those lands and waters in northern Madison County in Tennessee west of Highway 45, north of Passmore Lane, east of Scarbrough Loop Road and south of Highway 45W.

A more complete description may be found on file in the Real Estate Division office of Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency in Nashville, Tennessee.
