PROCLAMATION 12-16

TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF NO-WAKE ZONE ON WOLF RIVER

Pursuant to the authority granted by Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 69-9-209(b)(2) the Director of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, in concurrence with the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission, hereby proclaims the temporary suspension of Rule 1660-2-7-.35 (1) Wolf River. The temporary suspension is granted in association with a TWRA marine permit issued to Collierville Ski Club. The rule suspension is granted only to the participants and officials of the Ski Freeze Event on January 1, 2013, from the hours of 10:00 AM until 2:00 PM that day. Measures are being taken to assure the public health, safety and welfare and the aquatic habitat are reasonably protected and that adequate public notice is given.


