Chapter 0240-03-05  
Student Disciplinary Rules

Presented herein are proposed amendments of the Tennessee Board of Regents submitted pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, §4-05-202 in lieu of a rulemaking hearing. It is the intent of the Tennessee Board of Regents to promulgate these rules without a rulemaking hearing unless a petition requesting such hearing is filed within thirty (30) days of the publication date of the issue of the Tennessee Administrative Register in which the proposed amendments are published. Such petition to be effective must be filed in Suite 350 of the Genesco Park Building located at 1415 Murfreesboro Road, Nashville, TN 37217 and in the Department of State, Eighth Floor, William R. Snodgrass Tower, 312 Eighth Avenue, North, Nashville, TN 37243, and must be signed by twenty-five (25) persons who will be affected by the rules, or submitted by a municipality which will be affected by the rule, or an association of twenty-five (25) or more members, or any standing committee of the General Assembly.

The text of the proposed amendments is as follows:

Amendments

1. Subparagraph (h) of paragraph (2) of Rule 0240-03-05-.02 Disciplinary Offenses is amended by deleting the text of the subparagraph and substituting the following language, so that, as amended, subparagraph (h) shall read:

- (h) Firearms and other dangerous weapons. Any possession of or use of firearms or dangerous weapons of any kind including BB guns, Pellet guns, Paintball guns, water guns, cap guns, or other weapons that simulate a firearm.

2. Subparagraph (l) of paragraph (2) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is amended by deleting the text of the subparagraph and substituting the following language, so that, as amended, subparagraph (l) shall read:

- (l) Blue and White color Scheme. Designated parking areas on the campuses: blue lines for faculty/staff; white for residence hall parking, for commuter students, visitors, vendors and contractors.

3. Paragraph (3) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by adding a new subparagraph (h). New subparagraph (h) shall read:

- (h) The Gentry Center parking lot will be utilized for overflow parking. Shuttle service will be available through Facilities Management.

4. Subpart (i) of part 2. of subparagraph (a) of paragraph (4) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by deleting the text of the subpart and substituting the following language, so that, as amended, subpart (i) shall read:

- (i) All students registered in school as full-time, part-time, or special students are to register their vehicles with the T.S.U. Police Department within a three-day period after vehicles are brought to campus, display in the middle of the front windshield a hang tag parking permit and park in the White lines for commuter and residential students.

5. Subpart (iii) of part 2. of subparagraph (a) of paragraph (4) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by deleting the subpart in its entirety.

6. Part 1. of subparagraph (c) of paragraph (4) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by deleting the text of the part and substituting the following language, so that, as amended, part 1. shall read:

- 1. Motorists can park by backing in or head on positions.

7. Subparagraph (d) of paragraph (4) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by adding a new part 3. New part 3. shall read:

- 3. All students applying for handicap parking permits must meet with the office of Disabled Student Services before obtaining their parking permits from TSUPD. Disabled Student Services will forward the appropriate documentation to the Police Department Traffic Division.

8. Part 2. of subparagraph (e) of paragraph (4) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by the text of the part and substituting the following language, so that, as amended, part 2. shall read:

- 2. Visitors who have frequent occasion to visit the campus on business may apply for a visitor's parking permit. The application should be in written form (it shall be left to the discretion of the Vice President for Student Affairs whether or not these visitors should be charged a registration fee).

9. Subparagraph (b) of paragraph (5) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by deleting the text of the subparagraph and substituting the following language, so that, as amended, subparagraph (b) shall read:

- (b) The student permit shall be properly hung on the front windshield rearview mirror by midnight of the first Friday of the week that classes begin.

10. Subparagraph (d) of paragraph (5) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by deleting the subparagraph in its entirety and relettering the subsequent subparagraphs appropriately.

11. Subparagraph (d) (formerly (e)) of paragraph (5) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by adding a new part 3. New part 3. shall read:

- 3. Student permits are non-transferable.

12. Paragraph (6) of Rule 0240-03-05-.06 Traffic and Parking Regulations is further amended by deleting the paragraph in its entirety and renumbering the subsequent paragraphs appropriately.

The proposed rules set out herein were properly filed in the Department of State on the 16th day of January, 2007 and pursuant to the instructions set out above, and in the absence of the filing of an appropriate petition calling for a rulemaking hearing, will become effective on the 31st day of May, 2007.
