Amendments of Rules

Rule 1200-12-1-.04 Emergency Medical Technician is amended by adding the following language as a new subparagraph (1)(i):

- (i) An applicant shall cause to be submitted to the administrative office of the Division of Emergency Medical Services, directly from the vendor identified in the Division's licensure application materials, the result of a criminal background check.

Rule 1200-12-1-.18 Emergency Medical Dispatcher Standards is amended by adding the following new language as new part (4)(a) 4:

4. An applicant shall cause to be submitted to the administrative office of the Division of Emergency Medical Services, directly from the vendor identified in the Division's certification application materials, the result of a criminal background check.
