Chapter 0800-1-1  
Occupational Safety and Health Standards for General Industry

Presented herein are proposed amendments of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development, Division of Occupational Safety and Health submitted pursuant to T.C.A. §4-5-202 in lieu of a rulemaking hearing. It is the intent of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development to promulgate these amendments without a rulemaking hearing unless a petition requesting such hearing is filed within thirty (30) days of the publication date of the issue of the Tennessee Administrative Register in which the proposed amendments are published. Such petition to be effective must be filed in the Legal Services Office of the Department of Labor and Workforce Development, 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, Andrew Johnson Tower, 710 James Robertson Parkway, Nashville, TN 37243-0655, and in the Administrative Procedures Division of the Department of State, 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, William R. Snodgrass Building, 312 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, Nashville, TN 37243-0310, and must be signed by twenty-five (25) persons who will be affected by the amendments or submitted by a municipality which will be affected by the amendments, or an association of twenty-five (25) or more members, or any standing committee of the General Assembly.

The text of the proposed amendments is as follows:

Amendment

Paragraph (2) of Rule 0800-1-1-.06 Adoption and Citation of Federal Standards is amended by changing the date in the second line from "July 1, 2005" to "January 1, 2006", so that as amended the paragraph shall read:

- (2) The Commissioner of Labor and Workforce Development adopts the federal occupational safety and health standards codified in Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1910, as of January 1, 2006 except as provided in Rule 0800-1-1-.07 of this chapter.

The proposed rules set out herein were properly filed in the Department of State on the 12th day of September, 2005, and pursuant to the instructions set out above, and in the absence of the filing of an appropriate petition calling for a rulemaking hearing, will become effective on the 27th day of January, 2006.
