**ORDER REINSTATING AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE
COCOT SERVICES IN TENNESSEE**

This matter came before Chairman Sara Kyle, Director Eddie Roberson and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“TRA”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on January 8, 2007 to consider reinstating the authority of Total Telephone Concepts, Inc. (the “Company”) to offer Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone (“COCOT”) service in Tennessee.

The Company originally filed an Application to provide COCOT service within the State of Tennessee on October 12, 1998. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on November 17, 1998, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application.


Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-301(b) (2004), every owner or operator of a public pay telephone shall submit to the TRA an annual inspection and supervision fee for each service location on or before July 1 of each year. The Company was notified by mail on April 7, 2006 and July 12, 2006 of its failure to comply with the requirements of Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-

301(b) (2004). A Notice of Cancellation was mailed on August 4, 2006 via certified mail. When the Company failed to respond, this docket was placed on the November 20, 2006 Authority Conference for the voting panel to consider revocation of the Company's authority to provide COCOT service due to non-payment of fees. The panel proceeded to act on this matter and voted unanimously to revoke the Company's authority.


On November 20, 2006, the TRA received from the Company the outstanding annual inspection and supervision fees. Afterward, this matter was placed on the January 8, 2007 Authority Conference for reinstatement of the Company's authority. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to reinstate the authority of the Company to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The authority granted to Total Telephone Concepts, Inc. to provide COCOT service within the State of Tennessee is reinstated.
