ORDER GRANTING CANCELLATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE  
CUSTOMER OWNED COIN OR COINLESS OPERATED TELEPHONE SERVICE

This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Tre Hargett and Director Sara Kyle of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“TRA”), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on May 5, 2008. George P. Sword d/b/a ORD-Mark Communications (the “Company”) originally filed an Application to provide Customer Owned Coin or Coinless Operated Telephone (“COCOT”) service within the State of Tennessee on March 9, 2001. During a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on April 3, 2001, the Directors found that the Company had met all the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-2-.43 through 1220-4-2-.45 to provide COCOT service in Tennessee and approved the Application. On April 14, 2008, the Company requested that the TRA cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee. Based upon careful consideration of the record in this matter, the panel voted unanimously to grant the Company’s request to cancel its authority to provide COCOT service in Tennessee.
