Dear Mr. Hicks and Ms. Phillips:

In order to fully analyze the above-referenced *Petition*, the Tennessee Regulatory Authority requires additional information. Please provide the information requested below by June 25, 2007, and refer to this correspondence as Data Request No. 1 in the response.

1. Provide a listing of actions taken by the respective state commissions in all nine states in the former BellSouth operating territory regarding the transfer of AT&T of the South Central States, LLC residential local service customers.
2. Clarify which pages in Exhibit A of the *Petition* comprise the customer notice to be sent to AT&T of the South Central States customers.
3. Concerning TRA Rule 1220-4-2-.56(2)(d)(4), please explain how the customer notice in Exhibit A of the *Petition* informs transferred customers that they will receive a thirty day written notice of any rate increase that may affect their service up to ninety days from the date of the transfer.
4. Will any assets be transferred from AT&T of the South Central States to AT&T Tennessee as a result of the customer integration?
