**ORDER GRANTING ADDITIONAL TIME AND
ISSUING AMENDED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This matter came before the Hearing Officer upon the *Consumer Advocate’s Motion for Entry of a Procedural Schedule (“Motion”)* filed with the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (“Authority”) on September 24, 2008. In its *Motion*, the Consumer Advocate and Protection Division of the Office of the Attorney General and Reporter for the State of Tennessee (“Consumer Advocate”) requested an additional two weeks to file its pre-filed rebuttal testimony due to the unavailability of the CGC during the originally proposed date for the hearing of the week of October 20, 2008, the discovery process taking longer than expected, and the Consumer Advocate’s summer schedule on other matters.¹ Further, the Consumer Advocate requests that the Authority inform it and CGC of potential dates for a Hearing on the merits and to allow the parties to submit a proposed revised procedural schedule to completion.² Additionally, the Consumer Advocate asserts that the Chattanooga Gas Company (“CGC”) does not oppose its *Motion*.³

In consideration of the requests of the parties, the Authority panel assigned in this docket has established that the Hearing in this matter shall begin at 9:00 a.m. on November 3, 2008 and continue through November 4, 2008. Further, in the interests of time and efficiency, the Hearing Officer has prepared the Amended Procedural Schedule to completion of the docket, attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The *Consumer Advocate's Motion for Entry of a Procedural Schedule* is granted to the extent that an additional two weeks has been allowed for the filing of the Consumer Advocate's pre-filed rebuttal testimony, and the date for the Hearing on the merits has been established by the Panel.

2. The Amended Procedural Schedule, attached to this Order as **Exhibit A** is hereby adopted and in effect.

3. All filings shall be made in accordance with the Rules of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority.
