**ORDER GRANTING PERMISSION TO APPEAR PRO HAC VICE**

This matter is before the Hearing Officer upon the *Application to Appear Pro Hac Vice* filed by L. Craig Dowdy, attorney for Chattanooga Gas Company. The *Application* was filed on December 3, 2008.

Mr. Dowdy's *Application* states that he is licensed, in good standing, and admitted to practice law in the State of Georgia, the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia, and the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit, and further, that no disciplinary actions or investigations are pending against him.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Dowdy agrees to subject himself to the jurisdiction of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority") in any manner arising out of his conduct in such proceedings and agrees to be bound by the rules governing the conduct of attorneys appearing before the Authority.

This *Application* complies with Rule 19 of the Rules of the Tennessee Supreme Court and Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-1-2-.04(7). Accordingly, the application by L. Craig Dowdy for permission to practice before the Authority in the proceedings in this matter is granted.
