Dear Mrs. Standley:

Tennessee Wastewater Systems, Inc. provides the following information per your request dated March 11, 2008.

1. The Petition requested to provide wastewater service to approximately 750-900 residential and commercial lots with an initial 100 residential lots in Phase I and Phase II to be built by 2012. Please provide a complete timeline of the build out of the 750-900 lots including commercial lots.

Response: See Attachment "A" for a total development buildout schedule.

2. Please provide a schedule indicating when you anticipate the initial wastewater system will be constructed and all future expansions and/or additions. Please provide a detailed explanation of the utility's construction plans to serve the entire development of 750-900 lots.

Response: The initial wastewater system will likely be constructed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2008, with future expansion set to take place when the development buildout reaches approximately 100 homes. The developers of Milky Way Farms intend on constructing a golf course on the property which will utilize treated wastewater from our system to water the greens. This affects the design of the project by adding a storage pond to be built to hold the treated wastewater for course watering purposes. Additional treatment capacity for all future phases will be served by first directing the wastewater to a large deep cell facultative pond for secondary treatment, followed by running the wastewater through the original RSF treatment facility for tertiary, "polishing" treatment before storing the treated water in a holding pond for watering the course. Subsurface drip lines will be installed for an alternate means of dispersal if/when the treated wastewater supply outpaces the watering demands of the golf course.

3. Please provide original copies of the map and property cross index card that were previously provided. The ones provided are not clear.

Response: We are providing a replacement map (Exhibit "A") with all map and parcels shown. This map should serve the same purpose as the one filed originally.

4. Please provide a more detailed map of the area showing street names, etc.

Response: See Attachment "B" for a more detailed map.

5. Please provide the property cross index card for the remainder of the map and parcels being requested. Map 39 parcel 9.04 was the only one provided.

Response: The map provided on Exhibit "A" clearly shows all maps and parcels being requested and is provided in lieu of property index cards.

6. Please provide maps that detail where the first 100 lots and wastewater system will be built.

Response: See "Attachment C" for phase I lot and treatment system location information.

7. How many acres are planned to be used initially for the 100 lots and the wastewater system?

Response: Approximately 120 acres.







