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**ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF NAME CHANGE**

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This matter came before Chairman Eddie Roberson, Director Tre Hargett, and Director Ron Jones of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on June 23, 2008, upon the petition of Time Warner Telecom of the Mid-South, LLC ("Time Warner" or "Company") to change its name.

Time Warner was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") as a competing telecommunications service provider to provide intrastate private line and telecommunications access service in Tennessee as Time Warner AxS of Tennessee, L.P. on June 27, 1995, in Docket No. 93-02980. On October 1, 1996, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference, in Docket No. 96-01410, the panel found that the Company had met all TRA requirements and approved the name change to Time Warner Communications of the Mid-South, L.P. On April 6, 1999, in Docket No. 99-00165, Time Warner was granted a name change to Time Warner Telecom of the Mid-South, L.P. In an Order dated January 24, 2003, the Authority granted Time Warner Telecom of the Mid-South, L.P.'s request to transfer its CCN to provide

utility services pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-113 to Time Warner Telecom of the Mid-South, LLC in Docket No. 02-01296. On May 6, 2008, Time Warner Telecom of the Mid-South, LLC filed a Petition to change its name to tw telecom of tennessee llc.

Based upon careful consideration of the record of this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, a majority of the panel voted<sup>1</sup> to approve the name change.

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<sup>1</sup> Director Jones abstained from voting and asserted that Tenn. Comp. R. & Reg. 1220-4-1-.08 does not require Directors' approval for a name change, and further asserted that requiring such approval is in direct opposition to the Authority's decision in Rulemaking Docket No. 04-00072 and is contrary to the plain language of the Rule.
