TO THE INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT


This matter came before Director Eddie Roberson, Director Sara Kyle and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 28, 2008 to consider the Petition for approval of the amendment to the interconnection agreement negotiated between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. and IDS Telcom Corp.¹ filed on May 22, 2008.²

Based upon a review of the amendment, the record in this matter, and the standards for review set forth in 47 U.S.C. § 252, the Directors made findings consistent with those in the *Order Approving the Interconnection Agreement and Amendment Thereto* issued on June 5, 2006 in Docket No. 06-00082 and unanimously granted the Petition.


IT IS SO ORDERED.
