ORDER GRANTING APPROVAL OF AN ASSUMED NAME

This matter came before Chairman Tre Hargett, Director Eddie Roberson, and Director Mary W. Freeman of the Tennessee Regulatory Authority (the "Authority"), the voting panel assigned to this docket, at a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on July 28, 2008, upon the petition of Volunteer First Services, LLC ("VFS" or "Company") to add an assumed name.


Volunteer First Services, Inc. ("VFS, Inc.") was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") to provide competing local and interexchange telecommunications services, including exchange access, in Tennessee by an Order dated April 30, 2004, in Docket No. 03-00607. At a regularly scheduled Authority Conference held on December 17, 2007, in Docket No. 07-00255, the Directors voted unanimously to approve a transfer of VFS, Inc.'s CCN to VFS. On June 10, 2008, VFS filed a Petition to add the d/b/a of VolFirst. On June 23, 2008, the Company filed a request to waive the customer notification letter.

Based upon careful consideration of the record of this matter and upon a finding that the Company has satisfied the requirements of Tenn. Comp. R. & Regs. 1220-4-1-.08, the panel voted unanimously to approve the name change.


