DURING THE CORONA VIRUS COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY**

Dear Chairman Morrison:

Cumberland Basin Wastewater System, LLC (CBWS) has received your letter of March 19<sup>th</sup> requesting initial information along with weekly updates of our operational and response plans to ensure the continuity of safe and reliable utility service to our customers during this health emergency. Please consider this letter as CBWS's updated response to your request for July 7<sup>th</sup>.

CBWS currently provides wastewater service to 33 customers. At this time, no adjustments to our standard operating procedures have been required because of the Covid-19 outbreak. However, a required monthly inspection of the wastewater system is provided by our Certified Operator. If an issue develops with our Certified Operator, then CBWS will contract with a private provider to make the necessary inspections. CBWS is not currently aware of any other aspect of its operations that could be potentially impacted by the current health emergency.

CBWS will update our preparedness response to the Commission on a weekly basis. Please feel free to contact me anytime if you have any questions in regard to this response.
