11 And if they be ashamed of all that they
have done, shew them the form of the house,
and the fashion thereof, and he goings-out
thereof, and the comings-in thereof, and
all the forms thereof, and all the ordinan-
ces thereof; and all the forms thereof, and
all the laws thereof: and write it in their
fight, that they may keep the whole form
thereof, and all the ordinances thereof, and
do them.
12 This is the law of the house; Upon the
top of the mountain, the whole limit there-
of round about shall be most holy. Behold,
this is the law of the house.
13 ¶ And these are the measures of the
altar after the cubits: The cubit is a cubit
and an hand-breadth; even the bottom shall
be a cubit, and the breadth a cubit, and the
border thereof by the edge thereof round
about shall be a span: and this shall be the
higher place of the altar.
14 And from the bottom upon the ground
even to the lower settle shall be two cubits,
and the breadth one cubit; and from the
lower settle even to the greater settle shall be
four cubits, and the breadth one cubit.
15 So the altar shall be four cubits; and
from the altar and upward shall be four
horns.
16 And the altar shall be twelve cubits
long, twelve broad, square in the four
squares thereof.
17 And the settle shall be fourteen cubits
long, and fourteen broad in the four squares
thereof; and the border about it shall be half
a cubit; and the bottom thereof shall be a
cubit about; and his stairs shall look toward
the east.
18 ¶ And he said unto me, Son of man,
thus saith the Lord God, These are the or-
dinances of the altar in the day when they
shall make it, to offer burnt-offerings there-
on, and to sprinkle blood thereon.
19 And thou shalt give to the priests the
Levites that be of the seed of Zadok, which
approach unto me, to minister unto me,
saith the Lord God, a young bullock for a
burnt-offering.
20 ¶ Thou shalt take of the blood there-
of, and put it on the four horns of it, and
on the corners of the settle, and upon
