THE LATE JUDGE ROBERTSON.

Particulars of the Accident Which
Caused His Death.

The many friends in this city of Judge J. B. Robertson, will be pained to learn of his untimely and painful death, on Saturday evening last, at 9 o'clock, at his residence, No. 128 Orange street.

Judge Robertson left this city last Tuesday morning on Morgan's Railroad, Bayou des Allemands, where he had a business engagement with a Mr. Puman, of that place. Just before the train arrived at Bayou des Allemands, the Judge was informed that if he desired to get off, the train would be checked up so as to allow him to jump, as the train would not come to a full stop. On arriving at the station the train was checked up, and Judge Robertson attempted to jump off, when he lost his hold and fell under the wheels of one of the cars, and had one of his legs badly crushed.

As soon as the accident was discovered the train was stopped, when everything was done to lessen the unfortunate man's suffering. After leaving him with the kind people of the bayou the train proceeded on its way to Morgan City.

On the return of the train that evening for New Orleans, Judge Robertson was taken on board and brought to this city, and sent to his home, and Doctor De Roaldes was sent by the railroad company to attend him. Upon the arrival of the physician at the house, it was found that the leg would have to be amputated near the thigh, which was done at 9 o'clock that night.

From the time the amputation was performed the judge began to sink, and expired on the fourth day afterward. Just previous to his death he called his family to his bedside and bid them all a last farewell on earth, and instructed his son what to do after his death with his papers, and where to find them.

His funeral took place at 12 o'clock yesterday morning, from his late residence, and was attended by the members of the Marion Lodge No. 63, F. and A. M., of which he was a honored member. He was buried in the lodge tomb in the new Masonic burying ground at the Metairie Ridge.

Judge Robertson was, at the time of his death, in his fifty-second year, and leaves a large number of small children to mourn his untimely death.
