INTRODUCTION

The Albert F. Ganier, Sr., (1883-1973) Papers, 1786-1965, was a gift from Albert F. Granier, Jr. of Nashville, Tennessee and is housed in one and a half manuscript boxes. The collection consists of 800 items and occupies .75 cubic feet of shelf space. The collection has no restrictions.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Albert F. Granier, Sr. Papers, 1786-1965, contains information on genealogical material, land records, and grants in the Middle Tennessee area. Granier studied the land records of Davidson, Cheatham, and Williamson counties while researching the route of the original Natchez Trace.
