INTRODUCTION

The James Emerick Nagy Collection Addition is a continuation of the papers donated to the Tennessee State Library and Archives in 1982 by James Emerick Nagy (1903-1987), educator, scholar and historian of the early days of public education in Nashville, Tennessee.

This addition was given to the State Library and Archives as stated in the will of Mr. Nagy who passed away in Gallatin, Tennessee in 1987. This collection occupies 15.12 cubic feet of shelf space, and is comprised of approximately 13,500 items. Single photocopies of unpublished writings in the James Emerick Nagy Collection, Addition, 1723-1985 may be made for purposes of scholarly research.

- 1932-1941 Principal at Bailey Junior High School, Nashville, Tennessee.
- 1941-1946 Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds, Nashville Public School System, Nashville, Tennessee.
- 1946-1958 Director of Research and Statistics, Nashville, Public School System, Nashville, Tennessee.
- 1961 Earned Doctorate in Educational Administration, George Peabody College.
- 1987 December 31; died in Gallatin, Tennessee.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

In 1962, James Emerick Nagy (1903-1987) presented a collection of lifelong research to the Tennessee State Library and Archives. It contained 20,000 items pertaining to the Nashville Public School System. This addition to that collection contains some 13,500 items concerning Mr. Nagy's personal life, as well as his research on the public school system.

There are the usual personal records: account books, cards, cemetery records, certificates, correspondence, financial and legal documents, notebooks, obituaries and writings. There are newspaper clippings, diaries, genealogical data, lists of school employees, bound volumes of newspaper excerpts, photographs, printed material, school records, theses and writings.

There are also many bound volumes of information collected over the years by Mr. Nagy which were in his personal library. Most of these deal with early education in Nashville. Some included are: The Annual Reports of the Boards of Education from 1855 until 1946; Minutes of the Boards of Education in Nashville and Edgefield from 1854 until 1888; and Applicants and Employees of the Nashville City Schools from 1851 until 1888. Several copies of term papers, dissertations and theses dealing with topics concerning education and the early history of Nashville are valuable sources for research.

The photographs in this collection are outstanding. There are hundreds of pictures of classes dating from the late 1800s up until the 1940s. Photographs of early school buildings that have long since been razed, as well as streets scenes from around Nashville in the 1800s, offer a glimpse into Nashville's history. There are many photographs of teachers and administrators from the 1800s until the 1940s.
