## INTRODUCTION

This accession consists of three volumes of church minutes for the New Bethel Missionary Baptist Church, Goodlettsville, Tennessee, 1827-1996. These materials were loaned to the State Library and Archives for filming and the originals were returned to the church when filming was completed. Also included on the film are two published church histories. Volumes one, 1827-1944, and volume two, 1944-1967, are handwritten accounts. Volume three, 1869-1996, is typewritten and for the earlier years seems to contain minutes for only selected years.
