INTRODUCTION

The Dr. Marlin Luther Kirby (1844-1913) and Dr. Alvis Young Kirby (1874-1946) account books were loaned to the Tennessee State Library and Archives for Microfilming in October 200 by the Macon county Archives. After filming the books were returned.

Dr. Marlin Luther Kirby was the son of Jesse Kirby and Elizabeth Young, and was licensed to practice medicine on April 4, 1889. Dr. Alvis Young Kirby was the son of Dr. Marlin Luther Kirby and Martha Wakefield, and was licensed to practice medicine on April 3, 1905.
