## **INTRODUCTION**

The Travis Windrow and Azariah R. Dyer Store Ledger, Windrow's Campground, Rutherford County, Tennessee, was loaned to the Tennessee State Library and Archives for microfilming by owner Betty Blue Windrow Dye, College Grove, Tennessee. Caroline Smotherman, historian and genealogist from College Grove, Tennessee, organized the loan of the ledger to the State Library and Archives. After filming the ledger was returned to the loaner.

There are no restrictions on the use of the ledger. Photocopies of the ledger may be made for individual or scholarly use.

### **TRAVIS WINDROW AND AZARIAH R. DYER STORE LEDGER WINDROW'S CAMPGROUND (Rutherford County, Tennessee) April 6, 1866-1888**

Travis Windrow started a store in Rutherford County in April 1866. This ledger was a reuse of the Civil War era "Morning Report of the Sick and Wounded," ledger. Travis Windrow and Azariah R. Dyer were partners in the store. It begins as Travis Windrow, then in 1867 becomes Dyer and Windrow.

Travis Windrow was married to Catherine Pate. This ledger includes settlement notes of Travis Windrow's estate from 1878 through 1888. When Travis Windrow died Catherine married Azariah Dyer, who was also executor of the estate.

The ledger includes expenditures of the Rutherford County 12<sup>th</sup> Civil District School Fund for 1869. It also includes notes of the beginning of "Mount View Grangers" in 1873.
