**SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE**

Record Group 213 contains thirty-one bound volumes of the Budgets of Tennessee State Colleges, Universities and Special Schools for the years 1948 to 1972. These budgets were compiled by the institutions and submitted to the Department of Finance and Taxation (later the Department of Finance and Administration). These records can be used in the research of the evolution of institutions of higher education in Tennessee over the past thirty-five years. It is interesting to note the marked increase in the budgets of these institutions over this period of time.

For information on this subject, refer to Record Group 51, (Tenn.) Department of Education Records, 1931-1968; Record Group 92, (Tenn.) Commissioner of Education Records, 1913-1970; and Record Group 119, (Tenn.) Department of Finance and Taxation Records, 1927-1959, all of which are available on microfilm.
