## INTRODUCTION

Record Group 253, Save Outdoor Sculpture Survey, 1992, was a survey sponsored by the Smithsonian Institution and coordinated by the staff of the Tennessee State Museum. The purpose was to locate and describe the condition of outdoor sculpture in the state of Tennessee. The collection consists of nine Hollinger boxes of survey forms, 152 photographs and 65 slides. The photographs and slides are stored in the vault, separate from the collection. This collection was transferred from the Tennessee State Museum to the Tennessee State Library and Archives on March 20, 1998. These documents are copies of the originals that were sent to the Smithsonian Institution in Washington, D. C. that became a part of the *Save Outdoor Sculpture* survey that was a nation wide project sponsored by the Smithsonian Institution.

Original order was maintained during processing. This record group is arranged by counties beginning with Davidson, Knox, and Shelby. The counties are then arranged by three divisions, Eastern, Middle, and Western, then alphabetically. There are no restrictions on this record group for individual or scholarly use however, permission for commercial or other uses involving copyrighted art works should be obtained from the sponsors of the *Save Outdoor Sculpture* project.

## SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Save Outdoor Sculptures Survey was a nationwide survey project cosponsored by the National Institute for the Conservation of Cultural Property (NIC) and the National Museum of American Art, Smithsonian Institution. The *SOS!* project was supported by major contributions from the Getty Grant Program, the Henry Luce Foundation, and the Pew Charitable Trusts. Other assistance was provided by the National Endowment for the Arts, Adams & Rhinehart, Inc., and the Contributing Membership and Board of the Smithsonian National Associates Program. The purpose of the project was to determine the location, description, and condition of sculpture in the United States, to raise awareness about the condition of our nation's sculpture, and to promote its long-term care and maintenance. The information was gathered and recorded in each of the 50 states by volunteers using a survey questionnaire. Photographs and certain illustrations as needed were also provided by the volunteers. The resulting information became part of the Inventory of American Sculpture at the Smithsonian Institution's National Museum of American Art. The inventory became a permanent database of information for use by students, artists, curators, scholars, art historians, conservators and the general public.

The organization that administered the program in 1992 in the State of Tennessee was the Tennessee State Museum. The program was funded with the aid of a Federal Grant. State Museum staff traveled to Washington, D. C. for training in administrating the program in Tennessee. Regional volunteers were then organized by the Tennessee State Museum staff. Volunteers targeted for the project were local museum personnel, college art teachers, and art students. At the conclusion of the project the official copy of the survey was sent to Washington, D.C. and became a part of the national survey. This Record Group consists of the Tennessee State Museum's copy of the state wide survey. It is believed that it does not include the photographs submitted with the original documents that became a part of the national survey. Some of the surveys include a photocopy of the photograph that became part of the official document and others include extra copies of photographs or slides that were not used.

The type of information gathered in the survey included basic descriptive information, location or jurisdiction, condition, overall description, supplemental background materials, and surveyor information. The completeness of information found on each survey varies. Often complete information was not available or could not be found by the volunteers recruited to conduct the survey. Part One of the survey form asked for information concerning the title or titles of the work, the primary artist and other collaborators, execution dates or other applicable dates, materials used, approximate dimensions, and any markings and inscriptions. Part Two of the survey requests information concerning the location and jurisdiction of the sculpture. Since many of the works were not titled and were done by unknown artists the container list identifies those sculptures by their location. Part Three of the survey is concerned with the current condition of the sculpture and lists certain potential problem areas. Part Four asks the surveyor to give a brief overall narrative description of the sculpture, its subject or theme,

and overall condition. Part Five of the survey requests the surveyor to provide as much supplemental background material that could be found relating to the artist, subject, historical commissioning, patronage or funding, as well as previous conservation treatment histories. Part Six requests the name of the person that completed the survey and the date of the on site inspection. Photographs or drawings were requested as part of the survey and most include some type of image.
