INTRODUCTION

The Tennessee Sentencing Commission Minutes, 1990-1992, consists of ½ a cubic foot of documents that have been microfilmed. These records were transferred from the Records Center on April 30, 1996, in good condition. The records are arranged chronologically and contain the minutes of the meetings and agenda materials that were handed out at the meetings. These records represent only the minutes from 1990-1992. This commission evidently was created circa 1986. See the Commission History for more details.

This record group was microfilmed and the originals disposed of according to Tennessee State RDA #S528. This is a microfilm-only collection. There are no restrictions to access.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The Tennessee Sentencing Commission was created by the legislature to overhaul the criminal code and develop a consistent and equitable sentencing policy. This collection's biggest weakness is that it is not complete. The location of the records prior to 1990 and after 1992 is not known. Information found in this collection indicates that the commission was created by the legislature some time between 1981 and 1987. Refer to the Commission History (Folder 10) for additional details. The history contains two documents found in the collection that gives some insight as to when and why the commission was formed. This collection contains minutes of the commission meetings which are self explanatory. Agenda materials are also included. Agenda materials are photocopies of the specific laws taken from the Tennessee Code that were being discussed for possible revision.

The original size of the collection was one cubic foot. The finished size of the collection is ½ cubic foot of documents that have been microfilmed and disposed of.
